



## Device Purchase Terms & Conditions

Magnolia ISD is offering a limited number of Chromebooks and Windows Laptops for sale in response to our recent survey of district parents. Please read the following guidelines prior to placing an order for your child.

- Magnolia ISD will be offering up to 2000 Lenovo 100E Gen 2 Chromebooks part number 82CD0000US and up to 2000 Lenovo 300E touch screen Windows Laptop part number 81M90001US for sale. Please read additional specification and delivery information below.
- Parents or guardians of actively enrolled **2<sup>nd</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students** of Magnolia ISD may purchase up to any one device for their child's educational use while supplies last.
- Because the expectation is that your child will use the device to further his or her education while enrolled at Magnolia ISD, a district owned device will not be issued to any student who has purchased a device should they take part in any online learning programs through the district. If a device is issued while waiting for your personal device to arrive, the district device will need to be returned at the time of delivery.
- All devices on the MISD network regardless if they are district owned or personal are filtered for appropriate internet content while on the district network. District owned devices are also filtered when on personal non-district network. All personally owned devices including the devices offered for sale in this program are not filtered by the district when not on the district's network.
- These devices for sale are intended for use as a cloud-based device and will require you to provide internet access when away from the district network. The MISD online learning environment requires internet access regardless of the device you use.
- If your child uses this device on campus, all district policies regarding the use of personal device will apply. It is at the discretion of the teacher when the use of any electronic device is appropriate for use in class.
- Your child will be responsible for following the district's Acceptable Use Policy the same as if they were on a district owned device on or off campus.
- This sale will be conducted to ensure all legal and licensing requirements are met.
- All sales are final and orders must be paid in full.
- **The Lenovo 100E Chromebooks are expected to be delivered to the district on or about August 14, 2020, but this is subject to change.**
- **The Lenovo 300E Windows laptops have an expected delivery date of mid-October, but this is subject to change.**

- Each device comes with a one (1) year warranty that begins from the date delivered to the district, not the purchaser.
- Magnolia ISD assumes no responsibility for warranty related issues. It is the purchaser's responsibility to work directly with Lenovo to resolve any warranty related issues.

This device will run the Chrome browser and you can access Google Classroom from this device.
