As you are reading the article, consider the following questions:

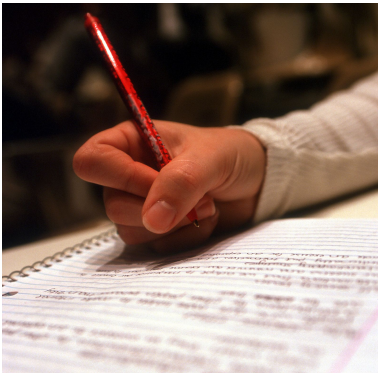
1. Which text features are included in this article?

Dividing fractions

This week students learn to divide a fraction by a fraction. Students begin the week by using their number sense. They use several strategies to reason about fraction division. On Friday, students are introduced to invert and multiply, a common procedural strategy. You may have learned this strategy in school. It is important to spend time early in the week reasoning about division and using students' number sense before emphasizing the standard

algorithm.

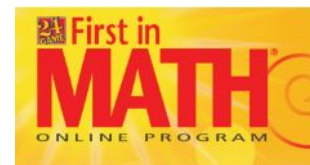
